

# 2024 UPSTATE COIN & GOLD YOUNG NUMISMATIST SCHOLARSHIP

Summer Seminar is an adult-level numismatic conference in an open-campus college setting. We recommend you thoroughly review the opportunities, seminar information, week at a glance, policies and regulations at https://www.money.org/summer-seminar/ prior to applying. As a recipient of the UCG YN Scholarship you will be subject to all ANA requirements during the Summer Seminar program.

The Summer Seminar offers two sessions from which to choose from: Session 1: Saturday, June 16 to Thursday, June 19 Session 2: Saturday, June 23 to Thursday, June 26

## **APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY:**

The applicant must be a full-time student and an ANA member age 13 to 17. Applicants must personally complete the application form, questionnaire and one page essay.

Applicants must receive a minimum of two references: one from their principal, teacher, or counselor, and one from another adult (other than a parent or relative). The person completing the reference, NOT the scholarship applicant, MUST submit reference letters to todd@upstatecoins.com by March 16, 2024.

#### **SELECTION PROCESS:**

Two scholarships will be awarded based on merit. Each application is thoroughly evaluated by a committee and scored according to the following categories -

- Engagement, Leadership and Accomplishments
- Essay and Questionnaire
- Reference letters

The selection committee's decision is final. Applications will remain confidential.

### TWO SCHOLARSHIPS WILL BE AWARDED:

Ages 13-17: Full scholarship covers tuition, lodging, and meals for one week, and up to \$1000 in travel reimbursement. (Note: ANA requires a parent or legal guardian to accompany applicants under the age of 15).

#### APPLICATION DEADLINE:

Applications and registration form must be received or postmarked on or before March 16, 2024.
